ORDINANCE NO. 02-O-2017-2018

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF STORM LAKE, IOWA BY CHANGING THE ZONING CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE IN WOODLAND CREEK 1ST ADDITION

WHEREAS, after due notice of intended action as provided by law, the City Council of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa, has determined that the zoning ordinance of this City should be amended as set forth below; and

WHEREAS, said action has been recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa;

WHEREAS, the City of Storm Lake needs housing for our workforce and a variety of types of housing to accommodate persons with varying housing needs and incomes;

WHEREAS, the owner and developer of Woodland Creek 1st Addition, MAG-SHU, LLC, believes there is a demand for housing types other than single family dwellings;

WHEREAS, such alternative forms of housing are permitted in R-3 districts but not in R-1 districts;

WHEREAS, more housing units can be constructed on the six lots identified below if they are zoned R-3 rather than R-1;

WHEREAS, the lots in Woodland Creek 1st Addition proposed to be rezoned to R-3 are the only lots in such Addition that, with some lot line adjustments, are both large enough and suitably configured for the alternative housing types permitted in R-3 districts;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 414.5 of the Code of Iowa, the City and MAG-SHU, LLC have entered into a Conditional Zoning Agreement dated September 18, 2017, that imposes certain reasonable conditions, over and above the regulations regarding R-1 and R-3 Zoning Districts, on the use of property within Woodland Creek 1st Addition, in order to satisfy public needs caused by the requested change in zoning classifications;

WHEREAS, upon the adoption and publication of this Ordinance, the said Conditional Zoning Agreement shall be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Buena Vista County, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the proposed change in districts is consistent with the City's comprehensive plan in that the plan envisions and encourages the development of alternative types of housing to accommodate the needs of the City's population.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa, that, pursuant to Article IV, Section 406 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa, the official zoning map, as referred to therein, is hereby amended as follows:

The real estate parcels legally described as:

Lots 1, 2, 12, 13, 14, and 15, Woodland Creek 1st Addition to the City of Storm Lake, Iowa,

are hereby rezoned from a classification of R-1 (Low Density Residential) to R-3 (Medium Density Residential), subject to the terms and conditions of the Conditional Zoning Agreement described above.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

Fireworks – Mayor opened the public hearing for use of consumer fireworks.

Mayor read to the council email receive from Roger Hart, 1402 W 6th Street supporting the firework proposed ordinance.

Joan Kurtz, 604 Lincoln Road, would like fireworks to be banned and added Ingrid Franze comment of limiting fireworks as much as possible.

Beth Dawson, 909 Pleasantview Drive, representing Mary Collin mentioned to be in agreement with the previous comment.

Pat Anderson, 700 Hickory Lane, would like the fireworks to be banned.

Jennet Waterman, 805 Elmwood Drive, agrees with previous comments.

Maggie Martinez, 430 Ontario, agrees with everything that has been mentioned.

Norma Dressen, 1311 W 7th Street, would like the fireworks banned expressing the concern of the debris and being shot of on the street.

Neil Gustafson, Aurelia, Iowa, owner Mr. G's highway stand started business to provide some fun for the 4th of July celebration. Feels that the fireworks ordinance is very disappointing but some compromises could be done. Commented that three weeks was a bit excess. Would request at least one day to be allowed. 2nd class fireworks will be hard to enforced.

Keri Navratil informed the council what the fire marshal website has classified as 1st and 2nd class.

Lynette Goodman, 709 Hickory, would not have a problem with allowing one day but anything longer would be a very long season as a pet owner.

Kathryn McKinley, 1208 W Milwaukee, support of what the police mention at the last fireworks meeting to have a total ban. People are not respecting the time period that was allowed. Sara Carlson, live and teaches in Storm Lake, agrees with Mr. Gustafson being in favor of fireworks. Does agree with the period of length being too long but would not like them to be

banned completely. Make a compromise that does not ban the fireworks but can be enjoyed for several days for years to come.

Barry Bittner, 712 Hickory Lane, suggested not banning fireworks but limiting the time and educate the public.

Jeff Young, 605 Geisinger, veterans with PTSD should be considered and ban fireworks. Lady spoke concerned with fireworks being shot off just last week.

Norma Thiesen, 1311 E 7th Street, commented that educating the public will not working as officer would inform the individual but continue shooting the fireworks soon after. Banning fireworks would be an excellent idea.

Hearing no additional comments Mayor then closed the public hearing.

CITY OF STORM LAKE CONTRACT FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICE

On this _____ day of _____, 2017, the following Agreement is reached between Charlotte Joyce Hopper, a single person, hereinafter referred to as "APPLICANT," and the City of Storm Lake, Iowa, hereinafter referred to as "CITY."

Background

CITY is a municipal corporation of the State of Iowa, located in Buena Vista County. CITY operates a public sanitary sewer system and is authorized by its Ordinance 3-2-10 to extend sanitary sewer service to property located outside the corporate limits of City.

APPLICANT desires to purchase sanitary sewer service from CITY.

The parties, therefore, agree that CITY will provide sanitary sewer service to APPLICANT and APPLICANT will purchase sanitary sewer service from CITY in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

Agreement

l. APPLICANT hereby requests sanitary sewer service to the following described premises:

Street Address: 1506 E. Milwaukee Avenue (also referred to as 600th Street), Storm Lake, Iowa

<u>Legal Description</u>: LOT TWO (2), BLOCK ONE (1), FERRY'S SUB-DIVISION OF PART OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW ½) OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE ½) OF SECTION TWO (2), TOWNSHIP NINETY (90) NORTH, RANGE THIRTY-SEVEN (37) WEST OF THE 5TH P.M.

APPLICANT hereby warrants that APPLICANT (individually or jointly, as appropriate) holds title in fee simple to the property described.

2. CITY hereby agrees to provide sanitary sewer service to APPLICANT to service the residence or commercial property located upon the property based upon APPLICANT's representation that APPLICANT does not own or have an undivided one-half interest or greater in any real estate that is contiguous to the above described property. The APPLICANT understands that all land owned by APPLICANT or in which the APPLICANT has an undivided one-half interest or greater that is contiguous to any land receiving services under this agreement must be included and subject to this Agreement. APPLICANT warrants that all land that must be included and subject to this agreement is included in the real estate legally described in Paragraph 1 above.

<u>Provisions Pertaining to Sanitary Sewer Service</u>

- 3. APPLICANT agrees that APPLICANT, at APPLICANT's expense, shall be solely responsible for constructing a sanitary sewer service line to the nearest available CITY sanitary sewer main and for constructing the connection between the service line and sanitary sewer main. In addition to the actual cost of construction and hook up to the CITY main, APPLICANT shall pay a special hook up fee in the amount of \$1,500.00 to CITY, which fee must be paid prior to the installation of the service line. CITY, at CITY's expense, shall extend its sanitary sewer main to a location in CITY's right-of-way adjacent to Applicant's property described above or described on attached Exhibit "A." APPLICANT, at APPLICANT's expense, shall also purchase from the CITY an i PERL water meter and shall have a licensed plumber install such meter to meter the residential water consumption at the APPLICANT's property, upon which consumption the CITY's sanitary sewer rates shall be applied to determine the CITY's charges to APPLICANT for sanitary sewer service. The cost of the water meter is \$333.47. APPLICANT shall pay such cost to the City before installation of the service line and connection to the CITY sanitary sewer main. The APPLICANT shall pay the cost to replace the water meter at such times as the CITY determines a replacement is needed. The CITY shall determine the type of any replacement water meter and the APPLICANT shall pay the cost of the replacement to CITY. Any replacement water meter shall be installed by a licensed Plumber at APPLICANT's expense. As the water meter will be measuring the consumption of water not supplied by the CITY, the CITY shall not charge the APPLICANT for water usage unless and until the CITY begins providing water service to APPLICANT's above-described property pursuant to a separate written agreement.
- 4. All installation of service lines and the subsequent maintenance thereof shall be done by a licensed plumber and no connections to the CITY's sanitary sewer main shall be made except upon specific authorization of the CITY and under appropriate supervision of CITY personnel.
- 5. For the provision of sanitary sewer service, CITY shall charge and APPLICANT agrees to pay to CITY fees equal to 150% of the base and user rates charged to CITY's residential, industrial or commercial consumers, as appropriate, payable monthly. The rate

referred to herein shall be the rate or rates applicable under the provisions of Chapter 3-3-4 of CITY's municipal code, as now in effect or as hereafter amended. APPLICANT shall be subject to the payment, penalty, lien, and deposit provisions of Chapter 3-3-5 of CITY's municipal code, as now in effect or as hereafter amended. If APPLICANT should request that billings be sent to any person other than APPLICANT, such as a tenant, APPLICANT shall nevertheless be liable for all payments due from the third party if the third party should default.

6. APPLICANT shall be bound by the provisions of Chapters 3-2 and 3-3 of the Storm Lake Municipal Code, as now in effect or as hereafter amended, relating to Sanitary Sewers and Sewer Rates that are otherwise applicable to users of the CITY's sanitary sewer system, except to the extent such provisions are inconsistent with the provisions of this Contract.

General Provisions

- 7. The term of this Contract shall be for a period of twenty-five years commencing on the date of this agreement. During the term of the Contract, it cannot be terminated by either party, in the absence of a breach of the Contract by the opposite party, except upon the written consent of both the CITY and the APPLICANT. This contract shall automatically renew for a twenty-five year term unless either party notifies the other party at least one year in advance of the termination of the contract that they desire to renegotiate the contract or terminate the contract. Notwithstanding the other terms of this Paragraph 7, should Applicant's property described in Paragraph 1 be annexed into the CITY, this Agreement shall then terminate and the CITY's sanitary sewer service shall be provided to such property in accordance with the terms of the provisions of the Storm Lake Municipal Code, as now in effect or as hereafter amended, that are applicable to users of the CITY'S sanitary sewer system.
- 8. a. As the property described in Paragraph 1 is now contiguous to the boundary of the CITY, APPLICANT shall file with the City Clerk of City a voluntary petition for annexation to the City of Storm Lake with respect to the property described in Paragraph 1 within thirty days of the date of this Agreement set forth in the initial introductory paragraph of this Agreement.
- b. If, during the term of the Contract, CITY shall initiate a plan to involuntarily annex territory including the property described in Paragraph l, APPLICANT shall not file or permit to be filed on APPLICANT'S behalf any resistance to the plan of involuntary annexation.
- c. To guarantee the effectiveness of the covenants contained in this paragraph, APPLICANT identifies the following person or persons who would have a dower interest in this property that are not otherwise parties to this Agreement, and by their signatures hereto, those persons with a dower interest hereby subordinate that dower interest and agree to be bound by the terms of this paragraph 8. Persons who would have a dower or spousal interest in this property are: None.

- 9. If APPLICANT should breach any of the provisions of this Agreement, CITY shall be entitled to bring an action for specific performance or for damages, as appropriate, and as an alternative to an action for specific performance and as an additional remedy in connection with or independent of an action for damages, CITY may terminate the Contract.
- 10. This Agreement shall run with the land described in Paragraph 1 and shall be binding upon the heirs, successors, and assigns of each of the parties.

BACKGROUND:

Early in 2011 during a Study Session discussion Council asked staff to look at putting together some analysis information regarding the amount of purchases made locally. We have pulled that information together and a provided a summary of purchases identified in the current list of bills to be approved that are purchased locally (within the City of Storm Lake), within Buena Vista County, and outside of Buena Vista County are presented here for Council's review. This information is presented for for both the City and King's Pointe's bills.

As the reader reviews the information they should note the following key notes:

- Costs associated with any major capital project (those bid under the State of Iowa Bid Law) are excluded from the calculation
- Costs associated with travel is excluded from the calculation and %
- Costs associated with payroll is excluded from the calculation and %
- In some cases there is only one vendor or an item is only available from vendors outside of the City limits and/or Buena Vista County we have not identified these
- Some departments have fairly minor budgets and a major purchase can skew the % and or amount for a given review period (For Example: the Airport may have normally \$4,000 \$6,000 in expenses until they purchase Jet Fuel or Av Gas which can be \$10,000 + and as a vendor who is not local this can skew the information for that review period)
- Local has been determined to be has an office front in the area and based on where
 the office front is located for local vs. BV County (For Example: Wal-Mart is
 considered local since they have a store in Storm Lake even though their headquarters
 is not located here)

As with all analytical data it is possible to interpret the numbers in a variety of ways and as we move forward we would be happy to provide further detail and or revise the way in which we show the data. Likewise if you have any questions or concerns please don't hesitate to contact city staff.

second-class consumer fireworks", however City Council may prohibit or limit the use of consumer fireworks. This ordinance would not allow the use of first-class consumer fireworks. The use of second-class consumer fireworks will be allowed on July 3

and 4 only between the hours of 5:00 pm. to 10:00 p.m.

ORDINANCE NO. 04-O-2017-2018

AN ORDINANCE AMENDNG CHAPTER 8-2 OF TITLE VIII OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF STORM LAKE, IOWA, TITLED "PUBLIC ORDER," TO REPEAL CERTAIN PROVISIONS PROHIBITING THE POSSESSION OF FIREWORKS, AND TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF "FIRST-CLASS CONSUMER FIREWORKS" AND LIMIT THE USE OF "SECOND-CLASS CONSUMER FIREWORKS" WITHIN THE CITY OF STORM LAKE, IOWA

WHEREAS, the Iowa Legislature has adopted and the Governor has signed Senate File 489 (SF 489), Eighty-Seventh General Assembly, which permits the sale and use of "first-class consumer fireworks" as now defined in Iowa Code Section 100.19(1)(c) and "second-class consumer fireworks" as now defined in Iowa Code Section 100.19(1)(e);

WHEREAS, SF 489 amends Iowa Code Section 364.2 by adopting a new Subsection 6 which provides that "a city council may by ordinance or resolution prohibit or limit the use of consumer fireworks, display fireworks, or novelties, as described in Section 727.2";

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Storm Lake City Council that the use of "first-class consumer fireworks" and "second-class consumer fireworks" in the City of Storm Lake, Iowa constitutes a threat to the public safety and private property and a nuisance to neighboring land owners;

WHEREAS, SF 489 amends Iowa Code Section 727.2 by, among other changes and additions, adding Section 727.2(3)(c)(1) which provides: "A person who uses or explodes consumer fireworks or novelties while the use of such devices is prohibited or limited by an ordinance adopted by the county or city in which the fireworks are used commits a simple misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars.";

WHEREAS, the City of Storm Lake, Iowa desires to prohibit the use of "first-class consumer fireworks," as now defined in Iowa Code Section 100.19(1)(c), and limit the use of "second-class consumer fireworks," as now defined in Iowa Code Section 100.19(1)(e), and to have the provisions of Section 727.2 (3)(c)(1) apply to unlawful use of "first-class consumer fireworks" and "second-class consumer fireworks" in the city of Storm Lake, Iowa; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of subsection I, headed, "Possession of Fireworks," of Section 8-2-1, headed "Misdemeanors" of the City Code of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa are now inconsistent with the provisions of SF 489.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Subsection (I) of Section 8-2-1, headed, "Possession of Fireworks," including such subsection heading and both subparagraphs 1 and 2 thereunder, being a part of Chapter 8-2 of Title VIII of the City Code of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa, is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 2</u>. The following new subsection (I) of Section 8-2-1, now headed, "Use of Consumer Fireworks'," is inserted in lieu of the subsection (I) of said Section 8-2-1 repealed by this ordinance:

- (I) Use of Consumer Fireworks:
- 1. The use of "first-class consumer fireworks," as defined in Section 100.19(1)(c) of the Code of Iowa, within the corporate limits of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa is prohibited.
- 2. The use of "second-class consumer fireworks," as defined in Section 100.19(1)(e) of the Code of Iowa, within the corporate limits of the City of Storm Lake, Iowa is prohibited except between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Central Time on July 3 of each year and between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. Central Time on July 4 of each year.
- 3. A person who violates a provision of this subsection (I) of Section 8-2-1 commits a simple misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than two hundred fifty dollars and not more than five hundred dollars. A court shall not order imprisonment for a violation of this subsection.

<u>Section 3</u>. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 4</u>. This ordinance shall be in effect following its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

AGREEMENT BETWEEN OWNER AND CONTRACTOR FOR CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT (STIPULATED PRICE)

THIS AGREEMENT is by and between	City of Storm Lake	_ ("Owner") and

Owner and Contractor hereby agree as fo	ollows:	

ARTICLE 1 – WORK

1.01 Contractor shall complete all Work as specified or indicated in the Contract Documents. The Work is generally described as follows: *Grading, Drainage Pipes and Structures, Erosion and Sediment Control, Concrete Pavement and Curb & Gutter, Vegetation Restoration*

ARTICLE 2 - THE PROJECT

2.01 The Project, of which the Work under the Contract Documents is a part, is generally described as follows: *King's Pointe Condominium Entrance Road Project*.

ARTICLE 3 – ENGINEER

- 3.01 The part of the Project that pertains to the Work has been designed by <u>Emmons & Oliver</u> <u>Resources, Inc.</u>
- 3.02 The Owner has retained <u>Emmons & Oliver Resources</u>, <u>Inc.</u>, ("Engineer") to act as Owner's representative, assume all duties and responsibilities, and have the rights and authority assigned to Engineer in the Contract Documents in connection with the completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.

ARTICLE 4 – CONTRACT TIMES

- 4.01 Time of the Essence
 - A. All time limits for Milestones, if any, Substantial Completion, and completion and readiness for final payment as stated in the Contract Documents are of the essence of the Contract.
- 4.02 Contract Times: Dates
 - A. The work under the Contract is divided into two portions, 1) Entrance Road Grading & Drainage, and 2) Concrete Curb & Gutter and Pavement.
 - B. The <u>first portion of</u> Work will be substantially completed on or before <u>January 31, 2018</u>, and <u>the second portion must be substantially complete on or before October 31, 2018 and all work will be completed and ready for final payment in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions on or before <u>December 31, 2018</u>.</u>

C. Entrance road grading and drainage to be completed by the first substantial completion date, with all concrete work (pcc pavement and curb & gutter) to start after August 31, 2018.

4.03 Liquidated Damages

- A. Contractor and Owner recognize that time is of the essence as stated in Paragraph 4.01 above and that Owner will suffer financial and other losses if the Work is not completed and Milestones not achieved within the times specified in Paragraph 4.02 above, plus any extensions thereof allowed in accordance with the Contract. The parties also recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving in a legal or arbitration proceeding the actual loss suffered by Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Owner and Contractor agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as a penalty):
 - Substantial Completion: Contractor shall pay Owner \$250.00 for each day that expires
 after the time (as duly adjusted pursuant to the Contract) specified in Paragraph
 4.02.A above for Substantial Completion until the Work is substantially complete.
 - Completion of Remaining Work: After Substantial Completion, if Contractor shall neglect, refuse, or fail to complete the remaining Work within the Contract Times (as duly adjusted pursuant to the Contract) for completion and readiness for final payment, Contractor shall pay Owner \$250.00 for each day that expires after such time until the Work is completed and ready for final payment.
 - 3. Liquidated damages for failing to timely attain Substantial Completion and final completion are not additive and will not be imposed concurrently.

Special Damages

- B. In addition to the amount provided for liquidated damages, Contractor shall reimburse Owner (1) for any fines or penalties imposed on Owner as a direct result of the Contractor's failure to attain Substantial Completion according to the Contract Times, and (2) for the actual costs reasonably incurred by Owner for engineering, construction observation, inspection, and administrative services needed after the time specified in Paragraph 4.02 for Substantial Completion (as duly adjusted pursuant to the Contract), until the Work is substantially complete.
- C. After Contractor achieves Substantial Completion, if Contractor shall neglect, refuse, or fail to complete the remaining Work within the Contract Times, Contractor shall reimburse Owner for the actual costs reasonably incurred by Owner for engineering, construction observation, inspection, and administrative services needed after the time specified in Paragraph 4.02 for Work to be completed and ready for final payment (as duly adjusted pursuant to the Contract), until the Work is completed and ready for final payment.

ARTICLE 5 – CONTRACT PRICE

- 5.01 Owner shall pay Contractor for completion of the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents the amounts that follow, subject to adjustment under the Contract:
 - A. For all Work, at the prices stated in Contractor's Bid, attached hereto as an exhibit.

ARTICLE 6 – PAYMENT PROCEDURES

- 6.01 Submittal and Processing of Payments
 - A. Contractor shall submit Applications for Payment in accordance with Article 15 of the General Conditions. Applications for Payment will be processed by Engineer as provided in the General Conditions. Contractor shall submit to Engineer for review at least 10 calendar days prior to the regularly scheduled monthly City Council meetings.

6.02 Progress Payments; Retainage

- A. Owner shall make progress payments on account of the Contract Price on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment no sooner than 7 calendar days after the regularly scheduled monthly City Council meeting on or about the ______day of each month during performance of the Work as provided in Paragraph 6.02.A.1 below, provided that such Applications for Payment have been submitted in a timely manner and otherwise meet the requirements of the Contract. All such payments will be measured by the Schedule of Values established as provided in the General Conditions (and in the case of Unit Price Work based on the number of units completed) or, in the event there is no Schedule of Values, as provided elsewhere in the Contract.
 - Prior to Substantial Completion, progress payments will be made in an amount equal
 to the percentage indicated below but, in each case, less the aggregate of payments
 previously made and less such amounts as Owner may withhold, including but not
 limited to liquidated damages, in accordance with the Contract
 - a. <u>95</u> percent of Work completed (with the balance being retainage). If the Work has been 50 percent completed as determined by Engineer, and if the character and progress of the Work have been satisfactory to Owner and Engineer, then as long as the character and progress of the Work remain satisfactory to Owner and Engineer, there will be no additional retainage; and
 - b. <u>50</u> percent of cost of materials and equipment not incorporated in the Work (with the balance being retainage).
- 3. Upon Substantial Completion, Owner shall pay an amount sufficient to increase total payments to Contractor to <u>100</u> percent of the Work completed, less such amounts set off by Owner pursuant to Paragraph 15.01.E of the General Conditions, and less <u>200</u> percent of Engineer's estimate of the value of Work to be completed or corrected as shown on the punch list of items to be completed or corrected prior to final payment.

6.03 Final Payment

A. Upon final completion and acceptance of the Work in accordance with Paragraph 15.06 of the General Conditions, Owner shall pay the remainder of the Contract Price as recommended by Engineer as provided in said Paragraph 15.06.

ARTICLE 7 – INTEREST

7.01 All amounts not paid when due shall bear interest at the rate of 1.50 percent per annum.

ARTICLE 8 – CONTRACTOR'S REPRESENTATIONS

- 8.01 In order to induce Owner to enter into this Contract, Contractor makes the following representations:
 - A. Contractor has examined and carefully studied the Contract Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Contract Documents.
 - B. Contractor has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and is satisfied as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - C. Contractor is familiar with and is satisfied as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
 - D. Contractor has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.
 - E. Contractor has considered the information known to Contractor itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Contract Documents; and the Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Contract Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Contractor; and (3) Contractor's safety precautions and programs.

Any provision or part of the Contract Documents held to be void or unenforceable under any Law or Regulation shall be deemed stricken, and all remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and binding upon Owner and Contractor, who agree that the Contract Documents shall be reformed to replace such stricken provision or part thereof with a valid and enforceable provision that comes as close as possible to expressing the intention of the stricken provision.

10.05 Contractor's Certifications

- A. Contractor certifies that it has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for or in executing the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 10.05:
 - "corrupt practice" means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of any thing of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process or in the Contract execution;
 - "fraudulent practice" means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process or the execution of the Contract to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish Bid or Contract prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
 - "collusive practice" means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish Bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and
 - "coercive practice" means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

10.06 Other Provisions

A. Owner stipulates that if the General Conditions that are made a part of this Contract are based on EJCDC® C-700, Standard General Conditions for the Construction Contract, published by the Engineers Joint Contract Documents Committee®, and if Owner is the party that has furnished said General Conditions, then Owner has plainly shown all modifications to the standard wording of such published document to the Contractor, through a process such as highlighting or "track changes" (redline/strikeout), or in the Supplementary Conditions.

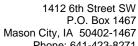

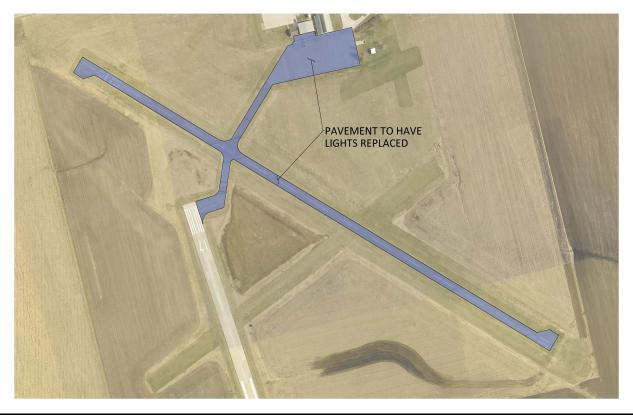

BACKGROUND: Branching Out is a nationally recognized grant program in which

Alliant Energy, Trees Forever, and local communities work together to carry out community tree-planting projects. The program is designed to encourage energy efficiency, volunteer

involvement, environmental awareness and community

stewardship in Iowa.

Branching Out is offered exclusively to Iowa communities where Alliant Energy provides electric and/or natural gas service. Alliant Energy provides grants of \$500 to \$10,000 for community-based tree-planting projects including streets, schools, public buildings,

trails, parks, entranceways, cemeteries, and more.

For this application cycle the City of Storm Lake will be applying

for trees to be planted in three different project locations

throughout the community. The three locations selected this year are the Russell Street and 10th park development area (15 trees), the Golf Course area (20 trees), and Russell Street and 10th Street park development (15 trees). City staff is asking this grant to fund the planting of 50 trees at the average cost of \$180 per

tree for a total of \$9,000.

FISCAL IMPACT: City staff is submitting a grant application in the amount of \$9,000

for the purchase of 50 trees at an average cost of \$180/tree. If funded, the City will provide stakes, mulch, and tree-tie material from materials that is already owned by the City. Labor will be done with City staff and community volunteers on designated

planting event day(s).

RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends that Council approve this grant submission in

Grants are awarded two times per year, to coincide with the spring and fall planting seasons. Applications are accepted on an ongoing basis throughout the year, but they are considered only in the next grant-making cycle (spring or fall). Your community may apply and receive funding for multiple projects in a single grant cycle.

- Projects should involve volunteers in planning, planting and caring for trees. If your community does not have an active tree committee, please form an advisory committee that will help you plan your project.
